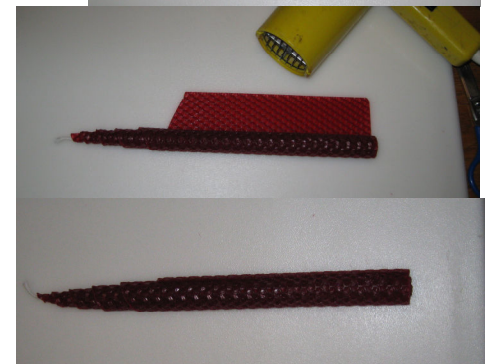
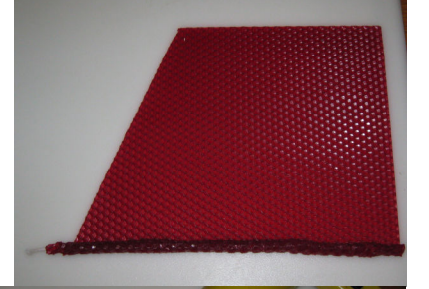
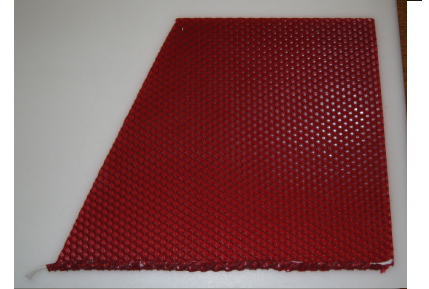
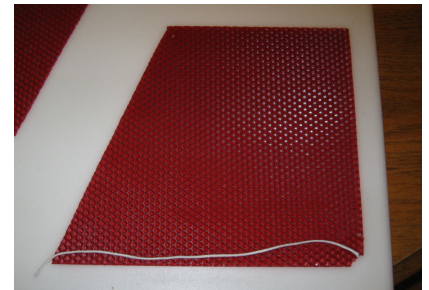
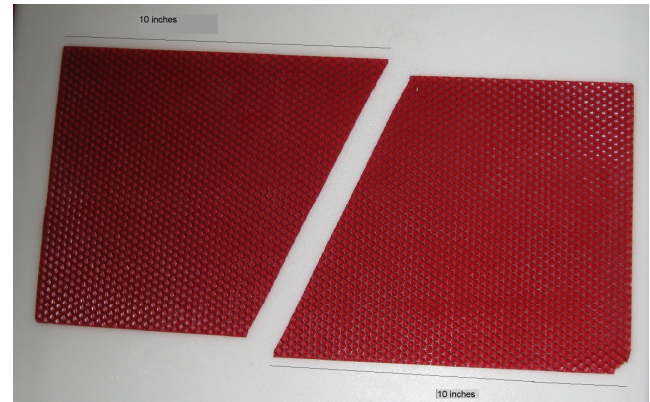


How to Make 10" Tapered Beeswax Candles

1. Lay beeswax sheet out on a cutting surface.
2. Make a small cut on the topside 10" from the left
3. Make another small cut on the bottom side 10" from the right
4. Using a straight edge and a sharp knife cut across the wax diagonally from one side to the other.
5. Cut a piece of wick about 11" long and place along the longest side with the extra 1" of wick on the angled side.
6. Using a blow dryer on low setting, gently warm the wax and fold it over the wick.
7. Warm the rest of the sheet and carefully roll the beeswax around the wick.
8. When you get to the other end, use the blow dryer to soften the wax.
9. Roll candle closed and gently press on seam



Variations: make your candle taller or shorter by cutting at more or less than 10" or make a pillar candle by cutting straight across.
